Why coordinate extra-curricular activities?

Schools want activities that are relevant to the curriculum, that meet their needs, that are high quality in terms of planning and communication as well as delivery, and that ultimately benefit their young people's life chances. Best practice from consultations with schools highlights the importance of accessing local cultural provision, incorporating teacher development into activities, school-school collaborations, and leveraging support and purposeful content from various sources.
