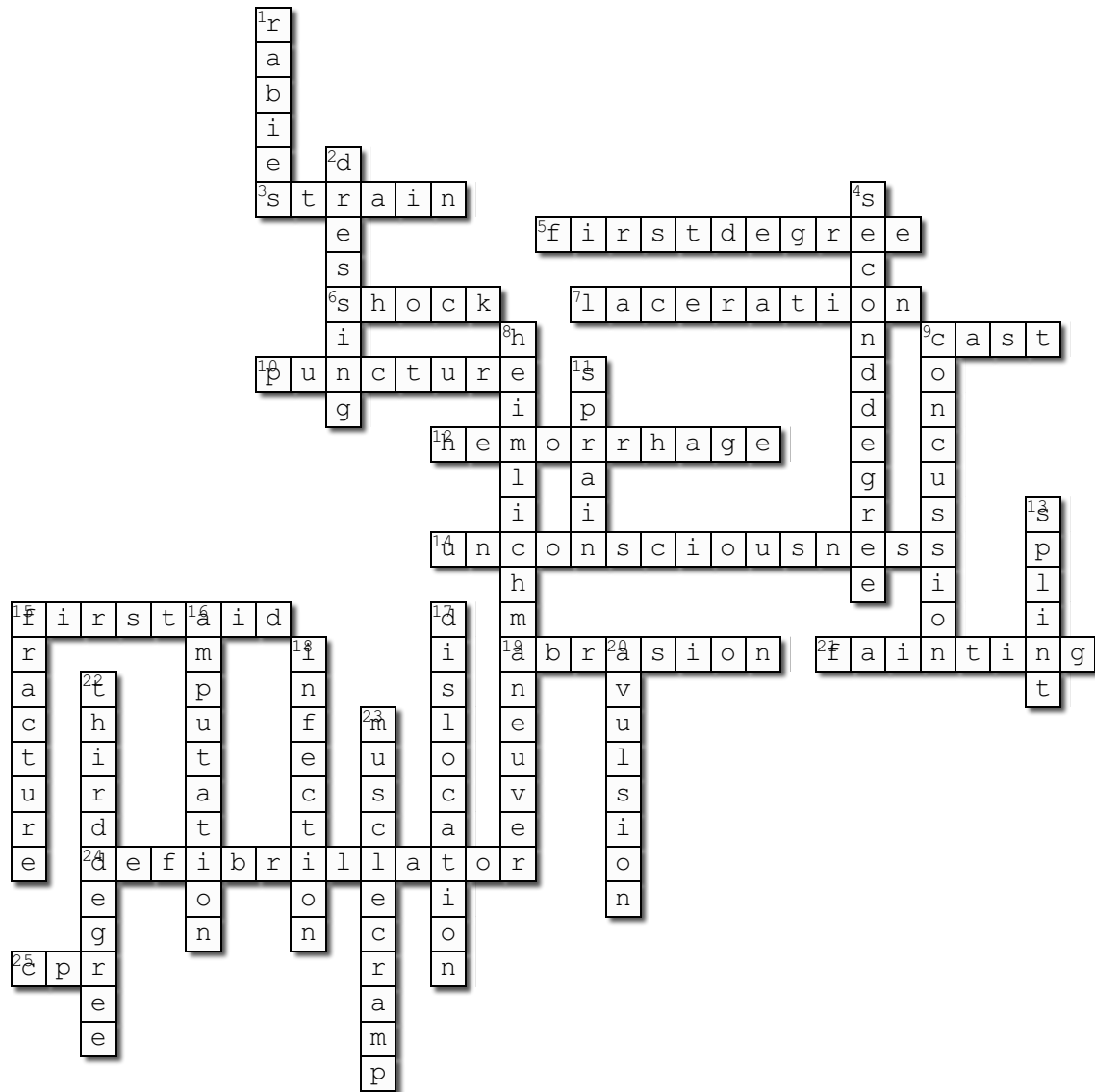

3. an injury to a muscle, usually resulting from overuse of a muscle (**strain**)
5. burn where only the outer layer of the skin is burned and turns red (**firstdegree**)
6. failure of the cardiovascular system to keep an adequate supply of blood circulating to the vital organs of the body (**shock**)
7. a cut caused by a sharp object, such as a knife or broken glass, slicing through the layers of the skin (**laceration**)
9. protective shell of fiberglass, plastic, or plaster, and bandage that is molded to protect fractured or broken limb(s) (**cast**)
10. a small but deep hole caused by a pin, nail, fang, or other object that pierces the skin (**puncture**)
12. an excessive discharge of blood (**hemorrhage**)
14. a condition in which a person is not alert and aware of his or her surroundings (**unconsciousness**)
15. immediate, temporary care given to an ill or injured person until professional medical care can be provided. (**firstaid**)
19. the skin is scraped against a hard surface, tiny blood vessels in the outer layers of the skin break (**abrasion**)
21. occurs when the blood supply to the brain is temporarily inadequate (**fainting**)
24. device that delivers an electric shock to the heart to restore its normal rhythm (**defibrillator**)
25. life-saving first-aid procedure that combines rescue breaths with chest compressions (**cpr**)

1. a viral disease of the nervous system that eventually causes paralysis and death if left untreated (**rabies**)
2. covering placed over a wound or injured part (**dressing**)
4. burn where the top several layers of the skin are damaged and may have blisters (**seconddegree**)
8. first aid procedure used to treat upper airway obstructions (or choking) by foreign objects (**heimlichmaneuver**)
9. a jarring injury to the brain that affects normal brain function (**concussion**)
11. an injury to a ligament that usually result from a twisting force (**sprain**)
13. trip of rigid material used for supporting and immobilizing a broken bone when it has been set (**splint**)
15. a break in the bone (**fracture**)
16. cutting off or separation of a body part from the body (**amputation**)
17. injury or disability caused when the normal position of a joint or other part of the body is disturbed (**dislocation**)
18. nvasion by organisms contamination by disease-product organisms or pathogens (**infection**)
20. esults when tissue is partially or completely separated from the body (**avulsion**)
22. burn where deeper layers of skin, and possibly fat, muscle, nerves, and bone are damaged (**thirddegree**)
23. the sudden and painful tightening of a muscle (**musclecramp**)
