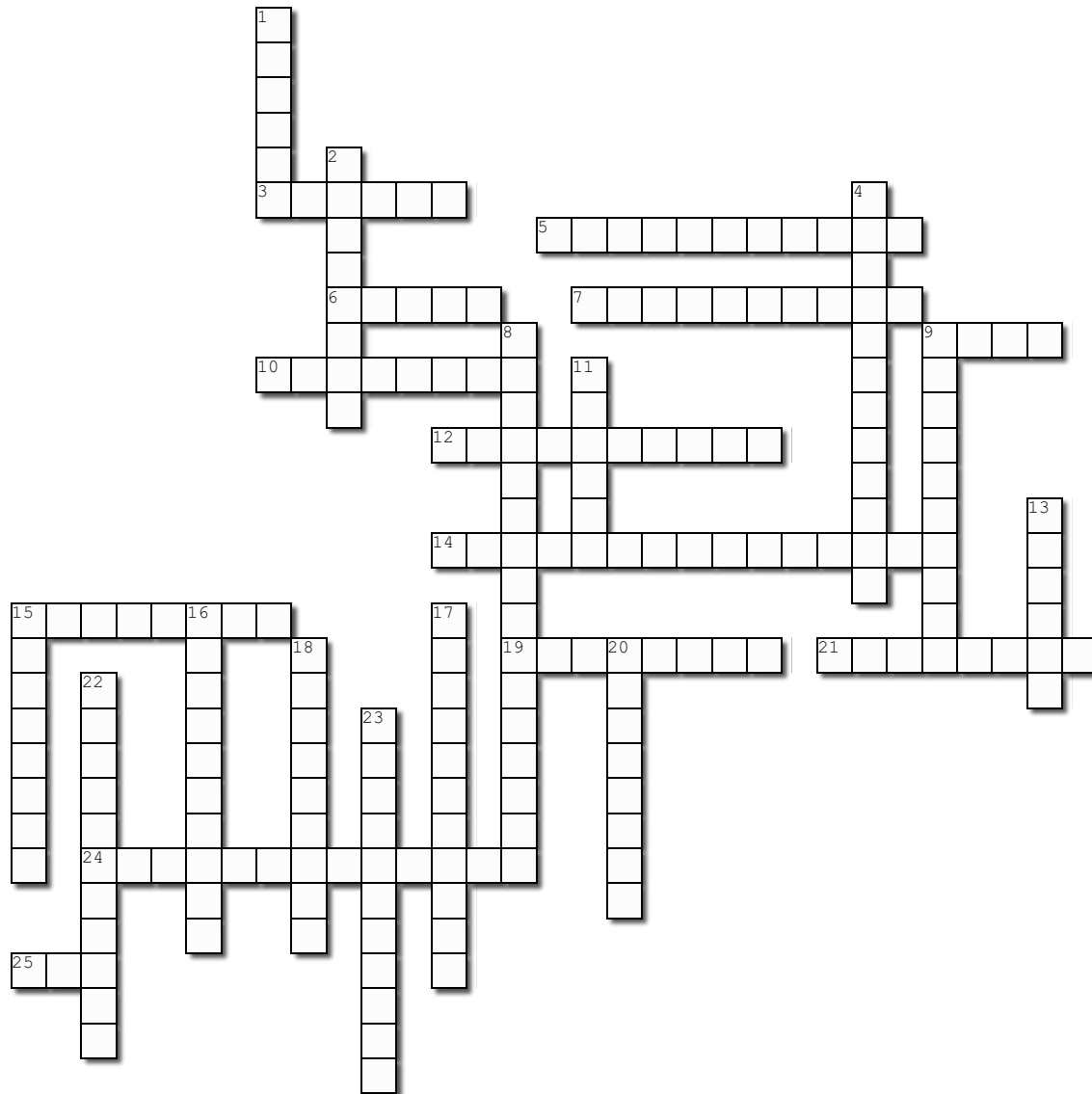


Safety and First Aid

7. a cut caused by a sharp object, such as a knife or broken glass, slicing through the layers of the skin
9. protective shell of fiberglass, plastic, or plaster, and bandage that is molded to protect fractured or broken limb(s)
10. a small but deep hole caused by a pin, nail, fang, or other object that pierces the skin
12. an excessive discharge of blood
14. a condition in which a person is not alert and aware of his or her surroundings
15. immediate, temporary care given to an ill or injured person until professional medical care can be provided.
19. the skin is scraped against a hard surface, tiny blood vessels in the outer layers of the skin break
21. occurs when the blood supply to the brain is temporarily inadequate
24. device that delivers an electric shock to the heart to restore its normal rhythm
25. life-saving first-aid procedure that combines rescue breaths with chest compressions

1. a viral disease of the nervous system that eventually causes paralysis and death if left untreated
2. covering placed over a wound or injured part
4. burn where the top several layers of the skin are damaged and may have blisters
8. first aid procedure used to treat upper airway obstructions (or choking) by foreign objects
9. a jarring injury to the brain that affects normal brain function
11. an injury to a ligament that usually result from a twisting force
13. trip of rigid material used for supporting and immobilizing a broken bone when it has been set
15. a break in the bone
16. cutting off or separation of a body part from the body
17. injury or disability caused when the normal position of a joint or other part of the body is disturbed
18. invasion by organisms contamination by disease-product organisms or pathogens
20. results when tissue is partially or completely separated from the body
22. burn where deeper layers of skin, and possibly fat, muscle, nerves, and bone are damaged
23. the sudden and painful tightening of a muscle
