A NEW PARTNERSHIP FOR NATURE Environmental Programme Launch 2026



Summary of the WCU x FC x QPP Environmental Programme



Following December's meeting, Westminster Children's University (WCU) is partnering with Floating Classroom (FC) and QPP to deliver a set of environmental initiatives in 2026, using WCU's green space as a core project site.

The programme includes two main strands:

Naturehood Watch – Wildlife Survey Workshops

A series of free, curriculum-linked workshops for Key Stage 2 pupils, exploring biodiversity through hands-on scientific investigation over three sessions:

- Winter (Jan–Feb 2026): Soil invertebrates
- Spring (Mar 2026): Bird species
- Summer (Apr–May 2026): Plant pollinators

Nature in the City – 2026 Youth Panel

A new five-year project led by Floating Classroom, recruiting 10–15 pupils in Years 5–6 to form a Youth Panel. Participants will act as peer researchers to reimagine an underused canal-side green space and shape future activities.
